Kogakuin University Visitors

Each February, about a dozen mechanical engineering students from Kogakuin University in Tokyo come to visit Harvey Mudd College for three weeks. Part of their experience includes a collaboration with an Engineering Clinic team. To help with the team assignment process, each team needs to complete this information sheet and return it to Lorena Gonzalez in the Engineering Clinic Office by November 30th.

If a Kogakuin student is assigned to your team, plan to have a well-defined task prepared and discussed with your advisor before the visitor arrives. The Kogakuin students have experience in mechanical engineering including CAD and machining; many have basic electronics knowledge as well. The visitors are here for a relatively short time and will encounter some language challenges, so expect to keep your project short and well-defined. Successful examples in the past have included making a SolidWorks drawing of a component that has been sketched or manufactured, building a mounting bracket in the machine shop, or building a small test circuit on a breadboard.
