Harvey Mudd College policy (refer to HMC Catalogue '11-'12, P. 108): After the first semester of the first year, a student may select one course or the equivalent of 3 units (in addition to physical education courses) each semester for which he/she will receive a grade of P (Pass) or F (Fail). However, none of the technical Core requirements may be taken on a pass/fail basis (except by departmental approval). In addition, departments may establish regulations about which of the courses required for a major may be taken on a pass/fail basis. Not more than one course (or the equivalent of 3 units) each academic year from any one department's course offerings may be selected on a pass/fail basis. Approval in writing must be obtained from the course instructor and the student's advisor. The selection of a pass/fail course or the change to letter grades cannot be made after the last day for dropping a course without academic penalty. A pass/fail course is omitted in computing grade averages unless the grade is "F". The grade "Pass" is equivalent to a C- or better in a course regularly graded.
