

GIRLSHMC Club Charter

Purpose

The GIRLSHMC club aims to give girls at Harvey Mudd an opportunity to meet in a non-academic setting to discuss issues concerning women on campus and enjoy the opportunities southern California offers for women. Our goal is to provide HMC girls with an outlet, a comfortable place where they can have fun with their femininity and take a break from our college environment which is predominantly controlled by men.

Method

GIRLSHMC plans to have bimonthly meetings or events throughout the duration of the academic year. Events will include but are not limited to ballet and arts trips, sporting events, pajama parties, karaoke nights, chic-flick movie nights, women's issues discussions, group manicure/pedicure trips, and trips to the beach.

Structure

Members:

Co Presidents

The president of the club shall organize club events, set meeting times and locations, and organize the GIRLSHMC booth at any Harvey Mudd club fairs. The president of the club will be elected by the officers before the end of every academic year.

Vice President

The vice president of the club shall facilitate the club president in organizing events, meetings, and club fair activities. The vice president of the club will be elected by the club members before the end of every academic year.

Treasurer

The Treasurer shall prepare budget requests, manage all funds, keep accurate records of all transactions, be prepared to submit audits to ASHMC Council, and to handle all other matters pertaining to the club's finances.

Membership:

No member or officer of this ASHMC Chartered organization shall be selected, dismissed, or discriminated against on the basis of age, race, religion, color, creed, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, or political affiliation. Additionally, we encourage HMC girls of all years and from all the dorms to join.
