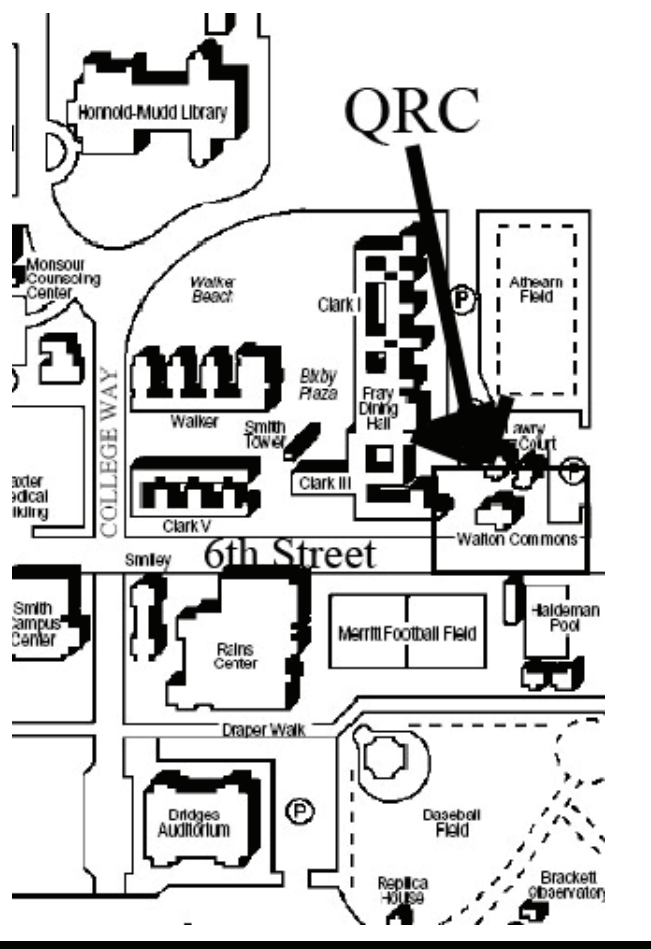

TRANScend is a five-college discussion-based organization focusing on genderqueer/transgender issues. We primarily emphasize community building with the end goal of grassroots activism. As well, we offer a safe space for Claremont College students of all genders and sexual orientations.

Women on Women (WOW) is a five-college group for queer and questioning women. The group focuses on developing a sense of community among queer women through discussion of issues affecting the community as well as social events.

Prism is Harvey Mudd College's queer student organization.

Queers of Faith is a five-college discussion group for queer, questioning and allied students of all faiths to talk about the issues surrounding their intersecting identities. It is a safe, confidential space for people to share personal experiences and discuss difficult questions with others.
