

GameSHMC Charter

I. Purpose

The Gamers' Society of Harvey Mudd College is designed to support and encourage the events of ITR Games, Crack in the AC, Powerdown, and other game sessions at Harvey Mudd College.

II. Method

There are two major events that are currently supported: ITR Games, Crack in the AC, and Powerdown.

GameSHMC will help provide funding, publicity, and logistics for these events.

GameSHMC may also use its resources to sponsor gaming events on its own.

There are also upon need Formal Sessions which will be attended by the cabinet and other active members to discuss issues and make changes as well as discuss issues that have arisen in the community.

Other types of events that may arise, such as weekly board games or video game sessions, will by default not be affiliated with GameSHMC. However, a liaison may be established with the consent of those who run/participate in the event and GameSHMC.

In order for an event to be affiliated with GameSHMC and to have a liaison appointed, it must involve a game, a group of participants, and meet regularly.

III. Structure

1. Officers

President

The President shall oversee cross-group issues and help settle disputes. Also vital for planning out special events put on by GameSHMC and presiding over the Formal Sessions. The President is elected by GameSHMC members.

Secretary

The Secretary is responsible for keeping minutes of Formal Sessions and organizing the agenda for Formal Sessions. The Secretary is elected by GameSHMC members.

Treasurer

The Treasurer shall prepare budget requests, manage all funds, keep accurate records of all transactions, be prepared to submit audits to ASHMC Council, and to handle all other matters pertaining to the club's finances. The Treasurer is elected by GameSHMC members.

Liaisons

An officer that is responsible for communicating the needs of the group to GameSHMC and acting as a representative of the group. Liaisons are appointed by the president, in the case of a new liaison position for a given event, or by the previous liaison, in the case of a previously existing liaison position for an event.

2. Membership

No member or officer of this ASHMC Chartered organization shall be selected, dismissed, or discriminated against on the basis of age, race, religion, color, creed, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, national origin, or political affiliation.
