Values

In the 100 Days report, Theme 1 on Culture and People highlighted what makes us remarkable-a focus on collaboration, a draw for all people who love STEM, membership in The Claremont Colleges, and a spirit of kindness. Perhaps using these statements as a guide, how would you articulate a set of values for Harvey Mudd?

Main messages

HMC aims to develop well-rounded students who are not only technically skilled but also equipped with the values and skills needed to positively impact the world. This is achieved through a focus on **excellence**, **collaboration**, **integrity**, **inclusion**, **belonging**, **wellbeing**, **and fostering a strong community**.

Essence

Theme 2, The Student Experience, and Theme 3, Academic Programs, point to aspects that are quintessentially Harvey Mudd: an Honor Code that infuses ethics throughout the community; strong faculty-student interaction, mentoring, and friendships; a Common Core that is fundamental to our being; and a liberal arts foundation and general degrees that are a base for the rest of life. Using these statements as a guide, how would you articulate a set of principles that speak to the essence of Harvey Mudd?

Main messages

Holistic Education: Combines STEM with humanities, social sciences, and the arts for a well-rounded perspective.

Collaboration and Interdisciplinarity: Encourages teamwork, breaking down disciplinary barriers, and making connections across fields.

Hands-on Learning and Problem Solving: Focuses on active learning, applying knowledge to solve real-world problems.

Broad-based Education: Cultivates diverse skills and interests beyond technical expertise.

Societal Impact: Prioritizes understanding the impact of work on society and fostering ethical, contributing citizens.

Entrepreneurial Mindset: Encourages innovation, creativity, and risk-taking in students.

Distinction

Beyond its core values and essence, what differentiates Harvey Mudd from its peers?

Main messages

Preparing students for the world: HMC aims to prepare students for complex challenges by teaching them STEM subjects alongside humanities and social responsibility. STEM without context and humanity is incomplete, and that success should include supporting others. **Dedication to STEM:** HMC is dedicated to attracting and educating passionate students who are dedicated to science.
