Summary:

Learn about Blue Sky, Conceptual, and Detailed Estimates, Budgets, Value Engineering, how all of those relate to each other and why we do them. The Shanahan Center project will be used as an example.

Bio:

James Hawley has 20 years of construction management experience in design/build private development, public works, theme parks, and educational facilities. He has directly managed over \$300 Million of design and construction, in addition to estimating over \$1 Billion worth of work. Hawley is currently directing planning and construction at Harvey Mudd College.

Hawley earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering, studying transportation systems, construction management and construction law at the University of California, Irvine. He has been active in the Associated General Contractors (AGC), serving on the Governmental Affairs Committee and directly lobbying governments on behalf of the construction industry. The AGC of Washington awarded Hawley the 2007 Affiliate of the Year for his contribution to the construction industry.
