

REPORTING INJURIES – INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO HMC CONSTITUENTS

INJURY REQUIRING IMMEDIATE MEDICAL ATTENTION <u>OR</u> INJURY THAT HAPPENS OUTSIDE OF BUSINESS HOURS

Remain calm and do not move the injured party unless his/her location poses a possible danger.
