

HEDS Alumni Survey Summer 2015 Selected Items Related to Primary Activity and Further Education



Response Ratesⁱ

Class of 201487/176 = 49.4%Class of 200961/143 = 42.6%Class of 200452/133 = 39%

Highlights:

- More than half (52%) of the respondents in the Class of 2014 were employed full time in the fall of 2014. Just over half (51%) of respondents in the Class of 2009 and 81% of respondents in the Class of 2004 were employed full time.
- More recent graduates were more likely to be in graduate or in graduate or professional school full time, with 40% of the respondents in the Class of 2014 and 41% in the class of 2009 in graduate or professional school full time. Only 4% of respondents in the Class of 2004 enrolled in graduate or professional school full time.
- 82-93% of respondents in each class indicated their undergraduate experience prepared them very much or quite a bit for graduate or professional school.
- 70-86% of respondents in each class indicated their undergraduate experience prepared them very much or quite a bit for their current career.
- Nearly one half (44-48%) of respondents in the classes of 2009 and 2004 had received a Master's degree by 2014, with another 4% of each class currently enrolled. 14% of the Class of 2014 is currently enrolled in a Master's program.
- More than one quarter (29%) of the respondents in the Class of 2014 and 34% of the respondents in the Class of 2009 are currently working toward a doctoral degree. More than a third (35%) of the Class of 2004 has completed a doctoral degree, with another 6% currently working toward a doctorate.
