Dear Prospective Music Ensemble Member:

Congratulations on being accepted to a Harvey Mudd College! Please accept our best wishes as you embark on this important time of study and preparation for the future.

One of the hallmarks of the Claremont Colleges is a strong commitment to music and the performing arts. The **Joint Music Program of Claremont McKenna**, **Harvey Mudd**, **Pitzer**, **and Scripps Colleges** provides exciting performing opportunities in ensembles of critically recognized quality and musicianship. While these ensembles are comprised of a number of music majors, the majority of our students come from a variety of interests and majors, from science and math to the social sciences, arts and humanities. These are the three Joint Music Program ensembles for which you may qualify:

The 40-50 voice <u>Claremont Concert Choir</u> (MUS 173JM, 1 CR) is an auditioned chorus performing *a cappella* and piano-accompanied literature from the renaissance to the present as well as major works of the 18th through 21st centuries with symphony orchestra. The Claremont Concert Choir regularly rehearses Mondays and Wednesdays from 5:35-6:45 p.m.

The 30-40 voice <u>Claremont Treble Singers</u> (MUS 176JM, 1 CR) is an auditioned ensemble specializing in music for soprano and alto voices from the renaissance to the present. The Treble Singers regularly rehearse Mondays and Wednesdays from 4:15-5:25 p.m.

The <u>Claremont Concert Orchestra</u> (MUS 175JM, 1 CR) is a 50-70 member auditioned symphony orchestra specializing in major orchestral works of the 18th through 21st centuries. Besides having its own concert series, it annually performs with the Concert Choir. The Claremont Concert Orchestra regularly rehearses Monday and Wednesday evenings from 7:30 to 9:00 p.m. The preparation process for each concert includes frequent sectionals with expert coaches from the greater Los Angeles area.

In the fall, the Claremont Concert Choir and the Claremont Treble Singers will host a choir alumni reunion in September, and perform a December concert of *a cappella* and piano-accompanied music by various composers. The Claremont Concert Orchestra's repertoire for the academic year include Mahler's First Symphony "Titan," Brahms' Violin Concerto and *Variations on a Theme by Joseph Haydn*, and other great works by Ravel and Fauré. At the end of 2018-2019, the ensembles will come together to perform Felix Mendelssohn's Symphony No. 2 *Lobgesang*. The accomplishments of these two ensembles are many, and we want you to join with us and your student colleagues from your own and other colleges in these highly regarded groups to create these magnificent works of musical art.

Joint Music Program ensemble **auditions** are held at the Scripps College Performing Arts Center (10th and Dartmouth Streets) at the end of new student orientation week, beginning September 1.
