## CITIZENSHIP STATUS VERIFICATION FORM

The Office of Financial Aid requires verification of your citizenship status prior to processing your official financial aid eligibility. To satisfy this requirement, you may submit a photocopy of the following:

- A copy of your birth certificate showing that you were born in the United States or the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, or the Northern Mariana Islands.
- A United States Passport (except limited passports issued for periods of less than five years)
- A copy of State Department documents Form FS-240, FS-545, or DS-1350 documenting citizenship.
- A Certificate of Citizenship (N-560 or N-561)
- A Certificate of Naturalization (N-550 or N-570)

While some Certificates of Citizenship and Naturalization instruct the holder not to photocopy them, the Department of Homeland Security has approved the photocopying of such documents for lawful purposes such as documenting eligibility for federal financial aid.
